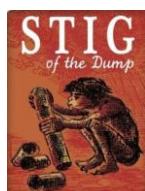

Books to read with your child

- Stig of the Dump by Clive King
- Cycles of Nature: The Carbon Cycle
- Water Cycle (Cycles in Nature) by Theresa Greenway

<b>English</b>	The children will be finishing off their topic of Stig of the Dump, create a final story using all the key skills they have learnt. They will then be moving on to developing their recounting skills in writing and learning new skills such as prepositions, front adverbials and paragraphs.
<b>Math's</b>	The children will be developing their understanding of addition, subtraction and multiplication. They will be developing their use of number lines, column method and number sentences to learn how to add and subtract with exchanging.
<b>Science</b>	The children will be learning about cycles in nature this term in science. They will be learning about all different types of natural cycles, such as life cycles, weather cycles and the water cycle. They will be growing their own plants to develop their understanding of cycles in nature.
<b>Geography</b>	The children will be looking at the topic of 'spatial sense', which will give the children key skills in understanding how to use a compass, use a map and understand what is around their local area. They will be learning how to map areas around Cambridge and identify human and physical geography.
<b>Music</b>	The children will be learning about different types of music and creating work around this. They will be identifying the beat and composing their own music using glockenspiels in pairs, also identify what music notes look like and mean.
<b>PSHE</b>	The children will be learning about three key topics this term; friends and family, anti-bullying and belonging. They will be understanding how all families are different and what makes family important. Also, they will be developing an idea of who they are and how to



	treat others around them to prevent bullying.
Art	The children will be learning about still life and from in art this term. They will be developing their sketching skills, looking at angles of shapes and using shadows to add effect. The class will be using objects and inspiration from famous artists like Andy Warhol and Herculaneum.
DT	The children will be focusing on their sewing skill this term. They will be creating their own bookmarks, using cross and running stitches. They will also be developing their fabric cutting skills and creating their own Christmas decoration to take home, showing off all their new skills.
RE	The children will be focusing on Christianity this term, looking into our theme of 'Salvation'. They will be learning about the Christmas story and developing their understanding of Christian values linked to the birth of Jesus.
PE	The children will be practice their dance skills this term by becoming dancing machines! They will be incorporating new movements to act like machines and work on sequencing a whole dance as a group!
French	The children will be developing the French greetings and colours this term. They will be working hard to have a multistep French conversation and to ask questions fluently. After this they will be developing their French writing to display the conversation they have just had.
ICT	The children will be developing their typing skills this term. They will be learning how to create documents and write online. They will also take part in a Microsoft Teams straining session, which will support their knowledge and understanding about Microsoft Office and Teams.
