The majority of PP is allocated to fund Teaching Assistant support in school, who work with all PP pupils across the year, in class and via 1:1/small group interventions. Interventions are bespoke to PP children, rather than specific packages, and are based on data analysis i.e. ensuring that accurate gaps are identified and addressed. This support is directed at closing gaps in core learning, which will prevent already disadvantaged pupils from being unable to meet ARE, and thus increase vulnerability. To ensure that progress for our More able, gifted and talented pupils with access to pupil premium funding also remains a key focus, we will continue to work on raising attainment for this group through extension work in class, extension days with partner agencies and funding extra-curricular activities.
