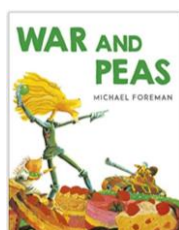

Books to read with your child

- War and Peas by Michael Foreman

English	The children will be learning about fables. The children will be identifying morals in the stories and using these to create their own fable short stories. The children's learning will be linked to the core text War and Peas by Michael Foreman.
Maths	The children will be identifying and representing numbers using different representations. They will learn how to find 10 or 100 more or less than a given number and read, write, compare and order numbers up to 1000 in numerals and in words.
Science	The children will learn about voluntary and involuntary muscles and their purpose. They will learn that some muscles, like our heart, move without us consciously thinking about it, but other muscles require us to command them to move.
History	The children will look at the historical concepts of continuity and change linked to stone age to the iron age. The children will be introduced to some important discoveries that archaeologists have made, which will help them see first-hand about interpretations of the past.
Music	The children will listen and appraise songs. They will be listening to the song ' Let your spirit fly'. They will build on their knowledge and understanding about the interrelated dimensions of music through warm up and flexible games.



PSHE	The children will learn about the range of changes that they and other children will experience in their lives. This will include wanted and unwanted change, those changes that are chosen for them, and changes that they choose for themselves.
Art	The children's focus will be lines. The children will understand that artists can use different line weight. They will explore how famous artists use lines in different ways, to show shape and texture. They will be taught to develop their techniques using fine motor control.
DT	The children will be focusing on healthy eating and adapting a recipe. They will be testing out their recipe and developing cooking skills. They will identify how to improve the recipe to be more nutritious and beneficial to their bodies health.
French	The children will focus on greetings. They will be able to say hello and goodbye French. They will learn to ask how someone is and ask others what they are called.
PE	The children be focusing on dance and ball games. The class will have a focus in dance around the solar system and creating their own sequenced dance. In ball games, the class will be developing their catching and throwing skills to improve team work and pace.
RE	The children will be considering the key question 'What do Christians learn from the creation story?' To do this, the children will place the concepts of God and Creation on a timeline of the Bible's 'Big Story' and describe what Christians do because they believe God is Creator.
ICT	The children will be learning about using paint tools. They will select, use and combine a variety of software (including internet services) on a range of digital devices to design and create a range of programs, systems and content that accomplish given goals. Also, they will be learning about E safety.
