**Books to read with your child**

- Egyptology: Search for the Tomb of Osiris
- The Everything Kids' Mummies, Pharaohs, and Pyramids Puzzle and Activity Book
- Ancient Egypt (DK Eyewitness)
- Light and Sound (Science Kids) by Mike Goldsmith

<b>English</b>	The children will be learning about description and biographies in English, based around the book 'The Firework Makers Daughter'. The children will be creating a variety of writing pieces based around the novel, developing their use of punctuation and grammar.
<b>Math's</b>	The children will be carrying on with our topic of multiplication and division from last term, focusing on 3s, 4s and the 8s timetables. After this, they will be learning about money and a new topic of statistics.
<b>Science</b>	The children will be focusing on the topic of 'Light' this term. They will be exploring different types of light and how it is made. They will be identifying how shadows are made and how they change due to light.
<b>History</b>	The children will be discovering about Ancient Egypt this term. They will be focusing on key information and learning how the empire was made. They will be learning about the discovery of Tutankhamen and Howard Carter. They will be able to interview someone who has visited the tomb of Tutankhamen and the Pyramids.
<b>Music</b>	This half term the children will be focusing on one song, Three Little Birds. The lesson will include elements of music such as pulse, rhythm and pitch. As well as singing and playing instruments, the children will be learning to improvise and compose with this song, whilst appraising other Reggae songs.
<b>PSHE</b>	The children will be focusing on the topic diversity and communities, they will be learning about what makes a community and what diversity is. The children will also be looking at the topic beginning and belonging, to understand our connections to family and communities.
<b>Art</b>	The children will be discovering about Ancient Egyptian art this term. They will be using clay to create Egyptian statues and making their own papyrus to mimic the Egyptian ones. This links to our History topic and will immerse them in the exciting past of Egyptians.
<b>DT</b>	The children will be creating their own wooden picture frames this term. Developing their skills in design and planning, as well as learning how to use various tools to create 3D picture frames.



	This will include thinking about their own risk assessments to ensure they keep safe.
RE	The children will be learning about a different religion this term, Hinduism. They will be discovering key information about the religion and how Hindus celebrate through festivals and important events.
PE	The children will be focusing on gymnastics this term. Developing their movement skills and working together in groups to create a sequence. They will focus on fine motor skills and core skills.
French	The children will be learning French greetings and colours this term. They will be working hard to have a multistep French conversation and to ask questions fluently. After this, they will be developing their French writing to display the conversation they have had.
ICT	The children will be developing their typing skills this term. They will be learning how to create documents and write online. They will be also focusing on a module about music creation, they will be able to learn how to compose and save their own music track.
