Did you know that 2,219 schools registered and over 757,803 pupils took part?

Congratulations to all our children, families and staff as we did amazingly well! We competed against other 'small' schools and achieved 15th position out of 43 schools in the East of England and 163rd out of 527 schools nationally. Our school's daily score including pupil journeys and pupil physical activities was 72.50%.

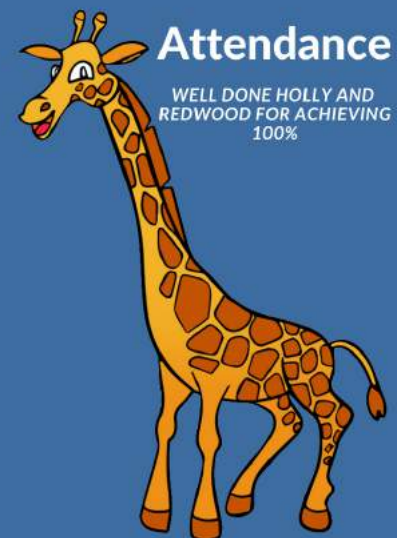

EYFS - Oak

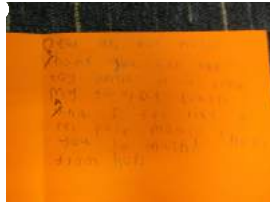

Year 5 - Maple Class

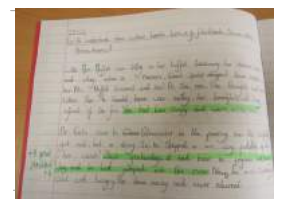
